SAFETY INSTRUCTOR/TECHNICIAN

POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting directly to the Market Q&S System Manager, this position will be primarily responsible for providing safety instruction for both new and existing employees. The Safety instructor will be accountable for providing classroom instruction for the following safety courses: CPR & First Aid, RF Awareness, OSHA 10 Hr., OSHA 30 Hr., Tower Operations and Rescue, and Customer specific courses such as "Ask Yourself". In addition to classroom instruction, he/she will be responsible for on-site safety inspections and follow-up as required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Facilitates learning through a variety of delivery methods to develop participants and skill sets. This includes classroom instruction, onsite demonstrations, hands-on Labs and participant coaching.

Responsible for administrative duties associated with conducting training, to include conducting all pre-training prep work, administering learning schedules and calendars, maintaining participant records (e.g., test scores, evaluations and attendance), performing all required post-training duties and ensuring learning is evaluated with post-training surveys.

Perform frequent site safety audits to identify all non-compliant equipment and/or processes at the site to ensure safety and quality.

Required Skills

3 + years of functional safety classroom instructions.

Excellent presentation and teaching skills are essential for training instructors.

Must be able to select the most appropriate training techniques according to the mix of classroom sessions, one-on-one coaching, demonstrations.

Ability to conduct assessments to measure the effectiveness of the training session
